





All camps are girls only unless otherwise noted. Register for camps and classes based on the student's rising grade. Enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis. After a course has reached capacity, students may be placed on a waiting list.

Unless otherwise specified, all courses require a 10 student minimum enrollment to run. Maximum enrollment varies by course. Courses that do not meet the minimum enrollment requirement are subject to cancellation.

St. Mary's Academy reserves the right to cancel a course. Families will be emailed two weeks before a course begins if a cancellation occurs. Participants will be given the option of a course change or a full refund.
